PSEA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS DUE TOMORROW, FRIDAY, MAY 14TH

PSEA is proud to announce the availability of Spring Scholarships to its Members, High School Seniors who are dependents of PSEA Members who are continuing their education, a Nominated PUSD Student by a PSEA Member, or a Member's dependent who has graduated from High School in the past 2 years.

PSEA Scholarships give Members and their dependents the help they need to achieve their goals. Scholarships will be awarded in increments of \$1,000.00 each unless there are not enough applicants; then the Scholarship Committee will have the discretion to increase the awarded increments up to \$2,000.00 each.

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of achieving a goal for higher education; which may include trade schools, vocational training, and colleges. Awards are granted without regard to race, creed, color, religion, gender, or national origin.

April 12 thru May 14: Deadline to submit application information. **Applications that are mailed must be postmarked by May 14, and mailed to the PSEA office. Personal deliveries will also be accepted in the PSEA office until 1:00pm on May 14.** The office is generally open from 8:30am to 3:30pm.
