#### **PSEA Scholarship Applications**

PSEA is proud to announce the availability of Spring Scholarships to its Members, to High School Seniors who are dependents of PSEA Members who are continuing their education, to a Nominated PUSD Student by a PSEA Member, or to a Member's dependent who has graduated from High School in the past 2 years.

Scholarships will be awarded in increments of \$1,000.00 each. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of achieving a goal for higher education; which may include trade schools, vocational training, and colleges. Scholarships will be awarded in early June. Application submission period is April 11th through May 13th. Mailed applications must be mailed to the PSEA office and postmarked by May 13th. Personal deliveries of applications to the PSEA must be received by 1:00pm on May 13th. The office is generally open from 8:00am to 3:30pm Monday through Friday. #### **REMINDER CPR/First Aid Certification Classes**

CPR/First Aid Certification classes are coordinated and offered through the District's Human Resources Department. Per our Collective Bargaining Agreement, District sponsored training sessions will be provided on a variety of days, times and locations, not less than four (4) times per year. Classes may or may not be offered on Professional Growth Days. The District will announce class offerings and details as they are available. Make sure you plan ahead for recertification prior to the expiration date of your current certification. More information on compensation for Unit Members who are required to attend license or certification classes as a condition of continued employment, i.e. CPR, can be found in Article 14.15 of the Unit I CBA:

Unit members who are required to attend license or certification classes as a condition of continued employment, i.e. CPR, shall receive compensation in accordance with the Fair Labor Standards Act and scheduled with Supervisor approval. For employees requested to have CPR/First Aid Certification by their supervisor and agreed to by the employee, time spent on training will be compensated in accordance with the Fair Labor Standards Act and the District will pay for the cost of the certificate.
